Assessor's Report: Annual county meeting. Projected increases for next year are showing an 8% increase in values. They office is doing some year end projects.

Road Report: HC Walsh said the equipment is running. They started the year with 120 tons of salt and they have already gone through more this year than they did all of last year. He ordered another 180 tons so they can stay on top of the roads. The new 6 wheeler is being built in Kankakee and he is hopeful it will be ready early next year.

Town Report: Supervisor Robbins received an email from Access Will County and they won't start the new bus service until January of 2026. He is in contact with Northpoint as well and he did ride with them into the project footprint. We have discontinued service with AT&T.

Trustee Comments: Trustee O'Connell asked that anyone who comes to Supervisor Robbins for general assistance also come to ShareFest, they provide to all the county residents household goods, food, and other items for residents in need. Trustee Hallihan mentioned Christmas Baskets and toys will be handed out on 12/20. 8:45-10:30am for packing bags.
